Lancaster, TX – There are numerous war movies, history books, and stories handed down from soldiers about how warplanes played a significant role in our fight for freedom over the years. Now is your opportunity to walk among some of those planes and experience up close the beauty and silent strength that earned them our respect and gratitude.

“Warbirds on Parade” will be held at the Lancaster Airport, Beltline Road at Ferris Road, Between I-45 and I-35 on Saturday, September 5, 2009 from 10:00AM to 4:00PM. Suggested donation is \$10 a carload or \$5 per person, so bring the family, a friend or a whole carload.

Rare WWII aircraft, military vehicles and memorabilia will be on display. Some of the 35 war birds attending last year’s event were the B17, Mustang, Corsair, Russian Hind D (the kind seen in the Rambo movies), AN2Colt and the Zero Replica. Donations will be accepted for rides on the R4D and the BT-15 after 4PM. We have also confirmed that the B-24A, OL’927 will attend our event. Consolidated Aircraft built 18,482 B-24s and only 2 still fly today. They will also be selling rides during the event.

Along with the aircraft, there will also be a display of some of the finest classic cars in the area. A raffle will be held for two round trip tickets anywhere that Southwest Airlines flies.
